

Appropriate attire for Christ the King ceremony, Prom, Graduation, Baccalaureate, & Alumnae Masses

Below is a listing of appropriate attire for your Senior year social events – Christ the King, Prom, Baccalaureate, and Commencement 2017. Please make appropriate choices.

- ❖ **Christ the King, Baccalaureate Mass, and Alumnae Mass:** Dress up!! Modesty and appropriate attire reign. Students who do not dress appropriately will NOT be able to participate in the ceremony. (Follow school uniform guidelines.)
 - No strapless or spaghetti strap dresses
 - No super short skirts
 - No bare midriff or excessive cleavage are to be shown
 - No low-slung pants
 - No shorts
 - No jeans – denim or corduroy

NOTE: For Christ the King – girls will be allowed to dress down during the school day following the guidelines above, but will wear a maroon gown for the actual ceremony.

- ❖ **Prom:** Modesty and appropriate attire reign. Gowns should be selected with these criteria in mind.
 - No slits to thigh
 - Strapless gowns may be worn if well supported
 - No deep plunge openings back or front, nothing cut lower than the shoulder blades in back
 - No sheer layered materials that reveal undergarments
- ❖ **Graduation:** In addition to the above mentioned rules, specifically for Commencement, these criteria apply:
 - All gowns must be **white – not ivory**, not light pink, not embroidered with pastel threads
 - All gowns must have at least spaghetti straps – **no strapless gowns**, nothing cut lower than the shoulder blades
 - Gowns must be **floor length** or **ankle length** – nothing shorter. **NO** tea length dresses.
 - Footwear must also be **white**. No gym shoes.
