** Note: SHA's Math Dept. highly recommends the TI84 Plus Silver Edition Texas Instrument Graphing Calculator. Each SHA student should have either a TI83 Plus, a TI83 Plus Silver Edition, a TI84 Plus, or a TI84 Plus Silver Edition Graphing Calculator which will be used during all 4 years of high school and into college. The TI84 Plus Silver Edition is the best calculator available; while it is the most expensive (typically lists at \$149.99), several stores (Office Depot, Office Max, Best Buy, Radio Shack, Wal Mart, etc.) offer discounts during the summer. Keep your eyes open for a great deal! The TI84 Plus Silver Edition is really the way to go as this particular calculator has lots of storage space allowing various applications and programs to be downloaded.

US History, US History Honors & AP US History

- 1 3 ring binder – select a larger size (2 1/2" inches +) if you plan to keep the entire year's notes/handouts/tests/worksheets/homework in one binder. If you prefer to carry a smaller binder around daily, then you will need to transfer the entire contents of the binder into a separate pocketed folder at the end of each quarter or semester. You will need to label the pocketed folders and store material chronologically so you can access it for midterms and finals.
- folders with pockets – if you plan to empty your binder during the year, you will need labeled folders to store the material in chronologically. If you will use one large binder for the whole year, then you need 1 folder for any extra material that will not fit in your binder.
- optional – dividers if you would like to label the units/time periods/material for easier reference
- loose leaf paper – keep a supply
- black or blue pens & pencils – keep a supply
- highlighters – in colors of your choice
