- 70 page college ruled journal (if lost, you must replace it)
- a pencil and two different colored pens (one black or blue and another colored pen of your choice)

MATH

CALCULATORS ** - SHA's Math Department requires the TI-84 graphing calculator (any edition - silver, plus, etc.), which will be used during all 4 years of high school and, likely, into college. While these calculators typically cost over \$100, several stores (Office Depot, Office Max, Best Buy, Radio Shack, WalMart, etc.) offer discounts during the summer, usually in August. Keep your eyes open for a great deal! Students enrolled in AP Calculus AB or BC are encouraged to purchase a TI-89 graphing calculator.

Earth Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- three ring binder/folder- calculator- pens & pencils- colored pencils
Exercise Physiology	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 1-1½" three ring binder & paper- dividers- graph paper- colored pencils- composition notebook
Intro. to Engineering	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- spiral or composition notebook of graph paper
Living Environment/ Biology Regents	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- pens, pencils & highlighters- crayons, colored pencils and/or markers- glue stick- scissors- folder or binder- one box tissues
Regents Chemistry	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 2" three ring binder- calculator, NOT a graphing calculator (you will NOT be allowed to use a graphing calculator on the Regents Exam)- writing utensils (pens and pencils)- folder
Regents Honors Chemistry	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 2" (min.) three ring binder- calculator, NOT a graphing calculator (you will NOT be allowed to use a graphing calculator on the Regents Exam)- dividers (to help you be more organized)- lined paper- writing utensils (pens and pencils)- folder
Regents Honors Physics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- small binder or folder- calculator (graphing or scientific calculator, either is acceptable on the Regents Exam)- metric ruler- protractor

AP World History Global History 9 Honors Global History 10 & Honors	- folder or binder (personal preference for organization) - one spiral notebook
AP Gov't. / AP Economics Economics Participation in Government	- 1" three ring binder or folder - pencils
AP US History	- three ring binder for notes and returned work - folder for returned homework - pencils, pens & highlighters
Global History 9	- 2" three ring binder - 8-10 dividers - lined paper - red, black & blue pen - colored pencils – a pack of 8 is sufficient
Sociology	- three ring binder
