Tuition Assistance Program



- What:** The Tuition Assistance Program, (TAP) is an opportunity for students to assist in the payment of tuition, while learning to take responsibility for assigned tasks.
- Who:** Any student whose family has a financial need and who is available to work every day at least one half hour after school. TAP workers must be dependable and conscientious. A student may be dropped from the program at any time if she is not reliable.
- Earnings:** Payment is \$6.00 per hour worked and will be directly credited to the student's tuition account.
- Work:** Duties include light cleaning, dusting and the like. Some students work in offices. Students start work promptly at after school.
- How to Enter Program:** In order to be accepted into the TAP program at Sacred Heart Academy for this coming year, a parent must complete the application at the bottom of this page, sign it, and have **the student also sign** that she understands the conditions stated above.
- Assignment of Work:** Student will be notified about work assignments the first week in September.
